Departing Trips

- Call (209) 668-5600 to request a pick-up from a location in Denair/Turlock.
- Calls must be made at least 1 hour before train arrival.
- Bus will pick you up from home and transport you to the Amtrak station.

Return Trips

- No reservations required.
- Bus will be waiting at Amtrak station during regular service hours.
- Bus will transport you to a location in Denair or Turlock.
