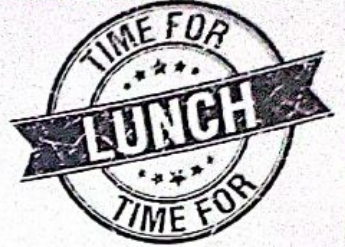

Meals on Wheels - home delivery

Meals on Wheels provides home delivered box of frozen meals for eligible homebound older adults.

Eligibility: To qualify for a home-delivered meal a person must be *60 years of age or older and be primarily home-bound due to physical or cognitive limitations. Those seniors that **live alone, are older & frail** are the highest priority for the home delivery service.

To apply for Home Delivery in Stanislaus County call the Senior Information Line 209 558-8698

What to expect: *The Home Delivered meals are produced by GA Foods. A weekly box of 5 frozen entrees, with milk, fruit or juice and a mini loaf of bread will be delivered **once a week** on a scheduled day/time (Generally Monday - Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.) depending on route assignment. Once approved, GA foods call center will contact you to notify you of your expected delivery day & time.



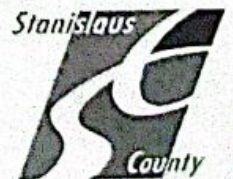
Above photo is example of a typical GA Foods van & delivery and a sample entrée.
