**III. Public Comments**

- A. Abandoned house [4216 Sperry Rd] – fence was fixed; people entering/leaving, feral cats present; County Code Enforcement followed up with property owner (moved to FL) in November 2022
- B. Boarded up house [Sperry Rd] – across the street from address listed above; No trespassing signage; requested an update from the County
- C. 4308-4316 Sperry Rd – construction zone with cones near telephone pole; not repaired for months; County will check with Planning Commission on any pulled planning permits
- D. Low flying helicopters a few weeks ago; Sherriff Department confirmed that between 3-5 pm support helicopter flights go out for routine calls
- E. Romie Way flooding – up to some garages; 5-acre field source of flooding; 3 drainpipes between field and canal; Don Rajewich handed out packet of info; dry well cleaned out; neighbors pumped dry well into field; Public Works supplied the fuel for the pump; the neighbors' activities helped Public Works out when they were overwhelmed with calls during the winter storm




