Community Reports:

Miguel Garcia, Stanislaus County Sheriff

Deputy Garcia mentioned of (53) speeding ticket violations in the past month in Empire. Claudia Manzo noted of the importance of upholding the speed limit especially when school starts on August 9, 2021.

Erick Moore, California Highway Patrol

Officer Moore mentioned of incidents down from last month, (6) non-injury collisions, (2) DUI arrest, and (1) stolen vehicle on B Street recovered. The CHP is short on staff but will enforce traffic more when school starts.

Mrs. Inacio provided information about rent assistance from Stan. Co., visit stanrentassit.com for additional information. She also noted for current vaccine locations to visit Stan. Co. Health Services website. In addition, she mentioned if any illegal dumping is noticed for license plate to be recorded and informed to Stan. Co. Sheriff and file complaint through Stan Connect. An attendee mentioned of about (20) streetlights throughout the community not working and/or are dim.
