

Knights Ferry Community Service District water treatment plant currently needs upgrading as it is 50 years old, we currently do not have the funds to do this. The request to accommodate this property development for water demands has been denied due to the following"

- 1. We currently have only enough water to satisfy the limited housing in the town of Knights Ferry.
- 2. The water tank is below grade or elevation and we don't have a pump to provide water up that hill.
- 3. The developer would need to finance this upgrade all at one time to provide water to each of these properties and have the amount of cost covered in the sale price as it can't be done parcel by parcel.
- 4. Water board meetings are the third Wednesday in the month 7 pm in the library to move forward with this project
