THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

IN RE: AUTHORIZING FORMATION OF THE SALIDA MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has received a request to establish a municipal advisory council in the community of Salida; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the establishment of the requested municipal advisory council would increase the participation of Salida in decisions affecting the community, and provide it with official representatives,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby establishes, as of January 1, 1985, a municipal advisory council in the community of Salida.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 31010 of the California Government Code:

1. The name of the municipal advisory council shall be known as the Salida Municipal Advisory Council;
2. The area for which the Council is established shall be the area known as the Salida General Plan Study Area as described in Attachment I.
3. The Council shall be empowered to: (a) advise the Board of Supervisors on planning, public works, public health, welfare, and safety matters which affect Salida, and such other matters as the Board of Supervisors may designate; and (b) to represent the community before any governmental agency or other organization on matters concerning the community.
4. The Council shall consist of five members, each of whom shall be a registered voter within the Salida Municipal Advisory Council boundaries.
5. The members shall be elected by the registered voters within the Salida Municipal Advisory Council boundaries at a special election to be held Tuesday, December 11, 1984. In accordance with the Elections Code:

- (a) A Notice of Election shall be published stating the time of the election and offices to be filled.
  - (b) The filing period for candidates will be from September 14, 1984 - October 8, 1984 and each must have the signatures of five to ten registered voters.
  - (c) The polling place will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 1984.
6. At its first meeting, the Council shall select two of its members who shall serve an initial term of two years expiring December 31, 1984. The remaining three shall serve for a four-year term expiring December 31, 1988. Thereafter, all members shall serve four-year terms.
7. The Council shall prepare and adopt bylaws for its operation. The bylaws shall become effective upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.
