- Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance
 The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

- 3. Public Comment
 - Keyes Community resident Roy Winters showed the Keyes MAC the fliers that he

 day 7 days a week.
 - Mr. Winters thanked the California Highway Patrol for coming to town but informed him that all the things like running stop signs and speeding loud cars are still happening. He would like to get the town cleaned up and work on cleaning up the alleys. He would like to see some people get together a few times a month and clean up the community. He spoke to Cal Trans about the sound wall that Keyes does not have. He expressed his concern with the potholes on Nunes Road and he stated his wife will not drink the water due to the smell of Clorox.

 - Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office
 Stanislaus County Sheriff stated that they use the Stan Connect app, it is a very useful tool. His team is in Keyes at this time serving search warrants and has

arrested ex-gang members and, in the process, retrieved some guns. If you have private property and a vehicle is abandoned you can call and have it towed, it is your property. The Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office will respond as quickly as possible when a call is made for an emergency.

b. California Highway Patrol

The California Highway Patrol responded to 16 accidents in Keyes. There was 1 major accident, 3 moderate accidents, 4 hit and run, 8 property damage, 3 DUI arrests, and 11 reckless driving. There were 3 stolen vehicles reported and 1 was recovered. If you have a problem, please call 209-545-7440, this is the CHP enforcement team, and we will come out as soon as possible.

k. Stanislaus Behavioral Health & Recovery Services

The Mobile Crisis Response Team works in the community to respond to crisis calls that involve psychiatric crisis or substance abuse crisis. You can access by 911 referrals through law enforcement, or you can call 1-888-376-6246. Option 4 is for the crisis team. This is a resource and support line. Option 3 is for appointments for mental health, to get an evaluation and to get connected to mental health services. Option 2 is for the crisis team. In March they received 150 referrals. 29 resulted in hospitalizations and 1 in an arrest.

I. Keyes Community Services District Chair Garza spoke on behalf of the Keyes CSD, he is the General Manger. They held their annual workshop on March 2, 2024. The main goal is to reconstruct the CSD building. The building will include a training center. Mr. Garza would like to speak with Member Reed to see if Spratling Middle School would be open to this type of training.
