THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

IN RE: APPROVING FORMATION OF THE KEYES MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has received a request to establish a municipal advisory council in the community of Keyes; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the establishment of the requested municipal advisory council would increase the participation of Keyes residents in decisions affecting them and provide the community with official representatives; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing was given by publication in the Turlock Journal, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Stanislaus on February 27, 1991, and this Board finds that legal notice has been given; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman called the public hearing, and all interested parties, both for and against the proposal were given the opportunity to testify and thereafter the public hearing was closed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the formation of a Municipal Advisory Council in Keyes with boundaries corresponding with the boundaries of the Keyes Union School District be, and hereby is, approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the MAC be elected rather than appointed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bylaws are hereby adopted as submitted.
