Public Comments/Community Concerns:

Salida resident, Michael Vigil was recognized for being a volunteer during the 2020 Point In Time Count.
Lana Moore thanked all who participated in the Salida Community Christmas Program.
Jose Dominguez and Elizabeth Talbot reminded the public to complete the 2020 census.

Monthly Reports:

Stanislaus County Supervisor, District 3: Reported County is in good shape and fiscally strong.

Stanislaus County Sheriff: Deputy Cody Cheary reported Salida crime stats went up slightly during the past 6 weeks, mostly because of an increase in burglaries.

Salida Fire Department: Pat Burns reported 75% of SFPD's call are medical related with a total of 1600 total calls for 2019.

California Highway Patrol: Officer Moore – CHP is monitoring street racing social media and teaching other agencies how to deal with street racing. Traffic related crimes were slightly up for December 2019. For traffic related concerns residents should call 209-545-7440.

Salida Sanitary District: Brad Johnson reported Salida Sanitary is looking at using recycled water for all new development landscaping.

MID: Stu Gilman: reported MID lost the first round in rate inequities...MID will likely appeal the decision.

Information Items/Special Presentation: Kristen Doud and Angela Freitas from Stanislaus County Planning and Development gave a presentation on new development project referral and the role of both the community and the MAC's.

Action Items:

Pacific Botanical Laboratories, LLC – PLN2019-0092. Unanimously approved by the Salida MAC
****Amended**** Referral Cal-Sierra Financial, Inc. – PLN2019-0079 – originally brought to the Salida MAC in September 2019. The community raised numerous concerns with this project and the Salida MAC unanimously rejected the proposal. The amended proposal states “not for semi truck use” and some visual and sound barriers were added. There are still many resident concerns that have not been addressed. It was recommended the

developer and the county set up a town hall meeting for concerned residents. No action taken by the Salida MAC Board.

Due to the late hour we were not able to hear a presentation on Lark Landing PLN2019-0131.
